

Area Development Update






- Construction is well under way for a senior housing (55+) apartment complex at Summerfields Blvd. and N. Riverside Drive
- This will bring a much-needed service to our area
- The SNA determined this development was preferrable to any development existing under the existing commercial zoning



Area Development Update






- A building is nearing completion between Penny Paws Veterinary Clinic and the 7-11 Convenience Store at N. Riverside Dr.
- This building will house a dental office and possibly a restaurant



Area Development Update






- The SNA has been working with DR Horton to zone the 300+ undeveloped acreage west of N. Riverside Dr. between Thompson Rd. and Basswood Blvd.
- We worked with the developer and succeeded in getting all commercial zoning along N. Riverside and Basswood reduced to Residential Commercial.
- Current planning calls for townhomes, single family homes and apartments
- Option being considered for a large City park
- This land also has been talked about for development of a professional socker complex, including a 10,000-seat covered stadium with auxiliary fields youth soccer fields
 - While the zoning is in place as an option to single family, the SNA does not expect the soccer complex to be approved
 - City would have to pay for and build the stadium which would cost more than \$50M, which is highly unlikely
